What is the Board of Directors? What do we do?

The Olympia Food Co-op Board of Directors is the elected body that represents the Membership by establishing policies, overseeing the operating and capital budgets, approving plans and recommendations, and setting general guidelines for Staff and Working Members. The Board holds ultimate legal responsibility for the operations and actions of the Co-op.

The board meets once a month, and each board member serves on at least two board committees.

Who Should Apply to be on the Board?

Many Members wonder if they should join the Board, but are worried they don't have prior experience. The truth is that we need people with passion, commitment and time. People who want to enthusiastically engage in board meetings and committee work.

People including but not limited to:

- People who want to learn about our co-op, or consensus decision making
- People who have experience with co-ops and consensus
- People who love food, cooperatives, volunteering, democratic process.
- People 18 years of age and older, of any economic status, race, gender, religion, ability, orientation

What are the requirements for being on the Board?

- Attend board meetings from 6:30-9:30p.m. the 3rd Thursday of the month.
- Join 2-3 committees which also meet 1-2 times per month (varies committee to committee.)
- Read and respond to emails regularly/in a timely manner.
- A minimum commitment of 10 hours a month.

What do I need to know about this election?

- This year the Board of Directors has 3 vacant seats.
- The lengths of Board Terms are 3 years.

What are the benefits of being on the Board?

- Board Members receive Volunteer Working Member credit for their time spent in Board and Committee meetings, and working on projects. Working member credit can be traded for a discount on purchases at the Co-op
- Board Members receive training on Consensus decision-making, Anti-oppression, Co-op's finances, policies and general procedures, and the history of the organization.

What's the Process?

- 1. Get to know the Board!** Board meetings are open to the public, if you're interested in joining the Board, sit in on a meeting and see if you're interested, our next meeting is August 17, 2017 6:30-9:30p.m. at our downtown office, 610 Columbia St. NW (this is not required).
- 2. Apply:** The Application period is 8am August 15th thru 9pm on September 15th.
To be eligible to run for the Board you must:
 - Be a member of the Co-op with a current address on file.
 - Be willing to make a 3-year commitment.
 - Be available for training in November/December/early January.
 - Be available the first weekend each June for our Board Retreat
- 3. Attend the Annual Meeting** October 28 3-8p.m. at the Olympia Community Center-222 Columbia St NW)
 - Each candidate will be given 3-5 minutes to speak to the Membership. It is also a great opportunity to mingle with the voters!
- 4. The Member Election takes place October 15th - November 15th @ 9pm** Ballots can be cast at any location of the Olympia Food Co-op or via USPS.
- 5. Election Results will be posted November 16th.** Candidates will be contacted directly with the results. At which time you will accept your position.
- 6. Training begins!**
Mandatory Board Trainings:
 - November 18th 10a.m.-2:30p.m.
 - November 30th 5:30-9:45p.m.
 - The January Meeting you begin your official service as a Member of the Board.
- 7. Officers of the Board are selected.**
- 8. Committee membership also selected.**
